

Language Placement Exam Instructions

- 1) Open a web browser and navigate to <http://languages.oberlin.edu/placement>
- 2) In the top right-hand corner, click on Login.
- 3) Sign up for an account. Be sure to enter your real name and your oberlin.edu email address.
- 4) Check your email for a message from languages@oberlin.edu. (You may wish to add this address to your list of contacts to avoid having this message marked as spam.) Click on the link in this message to confirm your account and validate your email address.
- 5) You'll now be taken to part one of the Language Placement Exam site. Click on the placement exam you would like to take. You will be asked to provide the following enrollment keys/passwords (which are all lower case):
 - For the French placement exam the password is: french
 - For the German placement exam the password is: german
 - For the Hispanic Studies placement exam, the password is: spanish
 - For the Russian placement exam the password is: russian
- 6) Complete the entire exam (parts 1 and 2) .
- 7) Results are graded by the language faculty and will be available from the individual departments beginning the afternoon after you take the exam.
